# **ACRYLIC LANDSCAPE PAINTING (All Levels) - 8 weeks**

Students will learn to create an acrylic landscape painting step by step while learning the fundamentals. The techniques covered in this course include building a foundation with underpainting layers, working dark to light, drybrush blending, and glazing.

### PALETTE KNIFE OIL PAINTING - 4 weeks

Students will learn to create an oil painting step by step while learning the fundamentals of creating the entire painting with a palette knife. The techniques covered in this course include building a foundation with underpainting layers, working dark to light, in thick impasto layers.

# **WATERCOLOR (Beginning) - 4 weeks**

This class is designed for beginning students to learn to compose and create a watercolor painting step by step. Starting with a light pencil sketch, students will learn watercolor techniques and sequencing while discussing color, composition, and perspective.

# **PAINTING LIGHT: Fundamentals of Oil Painting - 8 weeks**

This oil painting course will introduce students to the process of creating oil paintings that capture a strong sense of light in a variety of subject matter. Over the eight-week course, students will create four separate paintings.

# PET PORTRAITS IN ACRYLICS - 8 weeks

Students will learn the basics of animal anatomy and techniques for recreating the fur, scale, and feather textures. This course will review basic acrylic painting skills but assumes prior knowledge, beginners will be introduced to these skills if needed. Class will not meet July 4.

In this class, students will learn the basics of pottery through the lifecycle of clay. Class goals will include an understanding of all parts of the pottery process and final production goals of six to eight ceramic works (ideally two mugs, two bowls, two vases and two of student choice).

Whether you are new to pottery or have mastered the basics and ready to expand, Mixed Level Pottery is perfect for students at any level. Beginning students will learn how to throw pottery, trim feet, pull handles, and glaze their work as well as the general safety of working with clay and ceramic glazes. More advanced students will be introduced to more advanced techniques and held to higher expectation of work.
