### **Course Description**

This drawing and painting course is aimed at students who want to further advance their drawing skills and learn the basics of mixed media and watercolor. Students will be producing examples that can be used in a portfolio for college entrance. Drawing from life, students will learn sighting and observation techniques as well as the foundational elements of line quality, value, texture, composition, proportion, and scale. Students will build upon this drawing knowledge with an introduction to painting with watercolor. These painting techniques include learning to control their washes and their edges, color mixing, and painting from light to dark while learning techniques to preserve their whites.

## What will you learn?

Students will learn a higher level of drawing and painting techniques to accurately draw and paint from life. Students will improve their knowledge of art terms, theory, and history. They will learn the importance of practice and dedication to a skill to hone natural talent.
